


Single-Vendor Shopify Plugin Keys Setup Guide

Yo!Kart provides the feature of **importing products** from the Shopify platform.

This guide covers configuration settings for **users** who have been using the **single vendor** shopify account.

To configure the plugin, please log into the seller panel and then go to Seller Panel > **Plugins** > **Data Migration** > **Edit**.

To fetch keys required to import the data from an existing multi-vendor Shopify account, please follow the below steps -


Step 1 Login into your Shopify Store

1. Visit

<https://accounts.shopify.com/lookup?rid=094055e0-a977-4d81-ab85-75a0552fc7fe> and Log into your **Shopify** account using your credentials.

2. Once logged in, you will be redirected to the dashboard. Please copy the shop URL from the web browser. It is provided in the format-




Paste this url in the settings provided on Yo!Kart's Seller Panel > Plugins > Data Migration > **Edit > Shop URL.**

Step 2 Create An App


1. Go to **Settings** > select **Apps and Sales Channels** from left navigation menu options and click on the **Develop apps** button located at the right hand corner.



- Next, click on the **Allow custom app development button** to activate the custom app development facility. Follow the other prompts you may receive and select custom app development. You will be notified with a prompt message.



- Click on the **Create An App** button prompted on the App Development window.




4. Enter **App Name** and click on the **Create App** button to confirm.



Step 3 Admin API Integration

1. From the **App Development** overview tab, click on the **Configure Admin API scopes** button.




2. Next, add Filter Access Scopes using the search filters. Type **Products** in the search box and select the checkbox **read_products** and finally click on the **Save** button. **Configuration Saved** message is displayed to confirm the successful configuration.




Step 4 Install App

1. Click on the **Install App** that activates when you clicked on the **Save** button in the previous step.



2. Follow the prompts and click on **Install** button to confirm app installation.



3. Next on the **API credentials** tab you view API Access token key.
